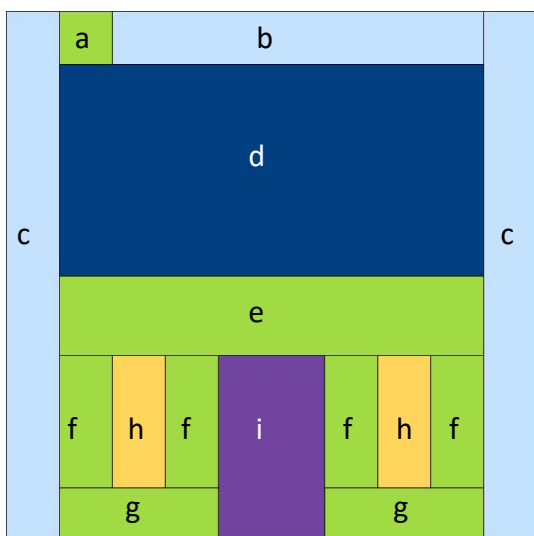

House 2

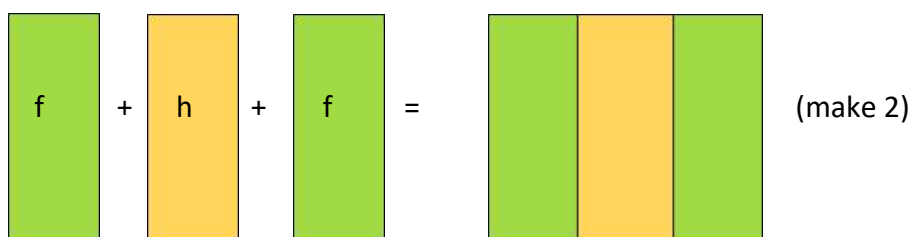


For this house, you'll need the following:

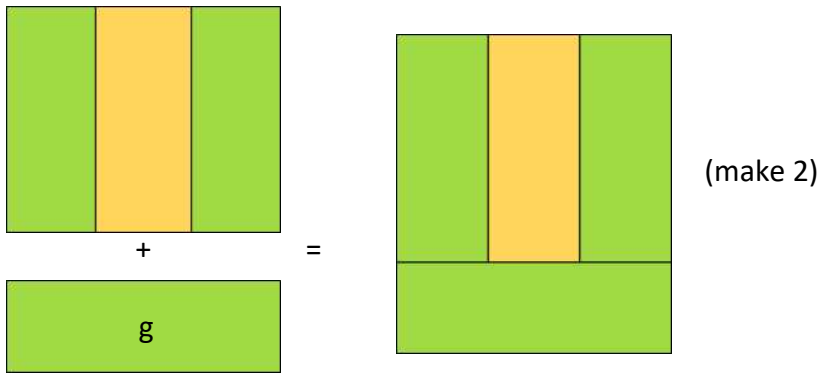
- a – House - 1-1/2" x 1-1/2" – 1 pc
- b – Sky – 1-1/2" x 7-1/2" – 1 pc
- c – Sky – 10-1/2" x 1-1/2" – 2 pcs
- d – Roof – 4-1/2" x 8-1/2" – 2 pc
- e – House – 2" x 8-1/2" – 1 pc
- f – House – 3" x 1-1/2" – 4 pcs
- g – House – 1-1/2" x 3-1/2" – 2 pcs
- h – Window – 3" x 1-1/2" – 2 pcs
- i – Door – 4" x 2-1/2" – 1 pc

To assemble

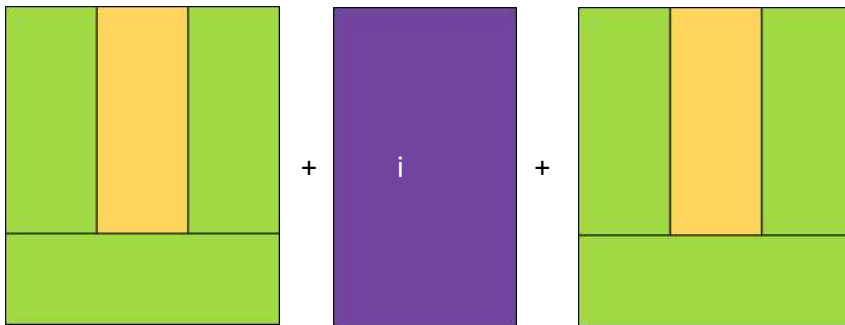
1. Start with sewing the window and walls together as shown below (repeat to make 2)



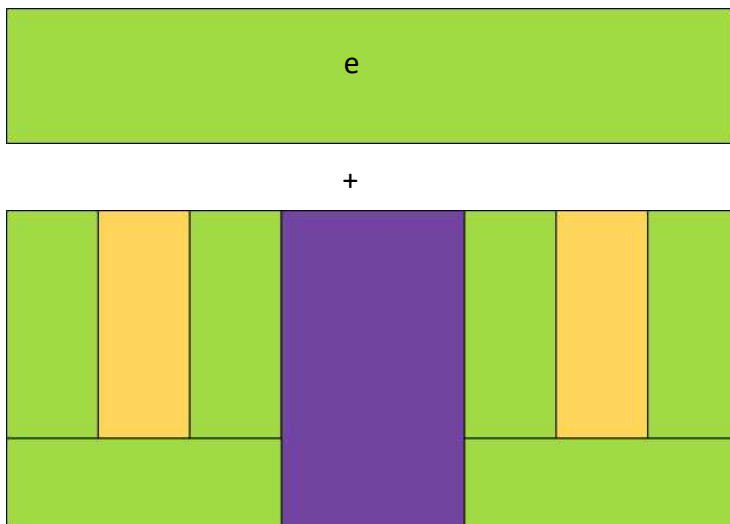
2. Add the wall beneath the section sewn in step 1 as shown below (repeat to make 2)



3. Sew the door to the first wall/window, then add the second wall/ window as shown below.

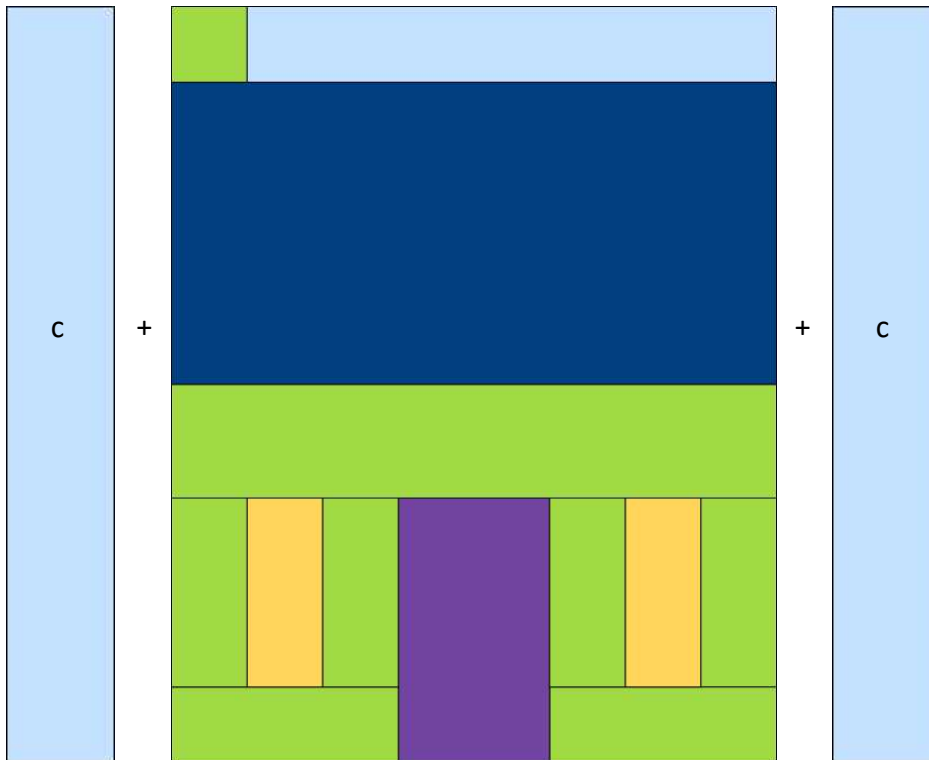


4. Add the wall to the top of the above section as shown below.

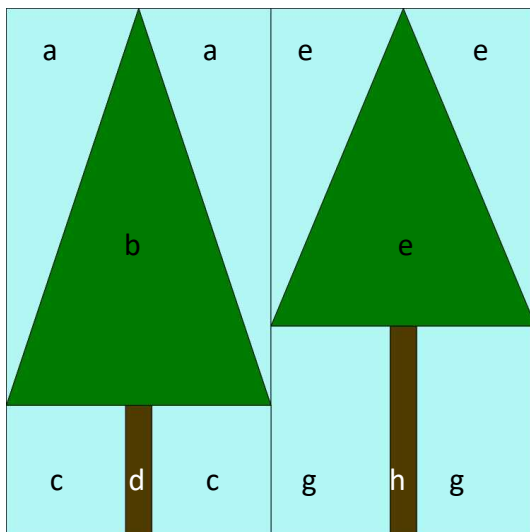




8. For the last step, Add the sky pieces to either side of the house.



### Tree 2 – Foundation pieced treetops



For this block, you'll need the following:

#### Tree 1 – on the left

- Sky 1 top – 10" x 5" cut in half on the diagonal
- Tree 1 – 8-1/4" x 5-3/4" min (for foundation piecing)
- Sky 1 bottom – 3" h x 2-3/4 w (2 pcs)
- Trunk 1 – 3" h x 1" w

#### Tree 2 – on the right

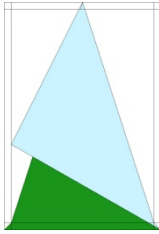
- Tree 2 – 7" x 6" min (for foundation piecing)
- Sky 2 top – 8-1/2" x 5" cut in half on the diagonal
- Sky 2 bottom – 4-1/2" h x 2-3/4" w (2 pcs)
- Trunk 2 – 4-1/2" h x 1" w



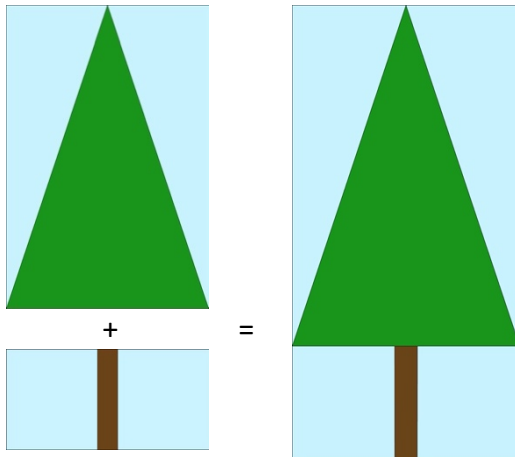
### To Make –

The method is the same for both trees, so instructions will only be given for the first.

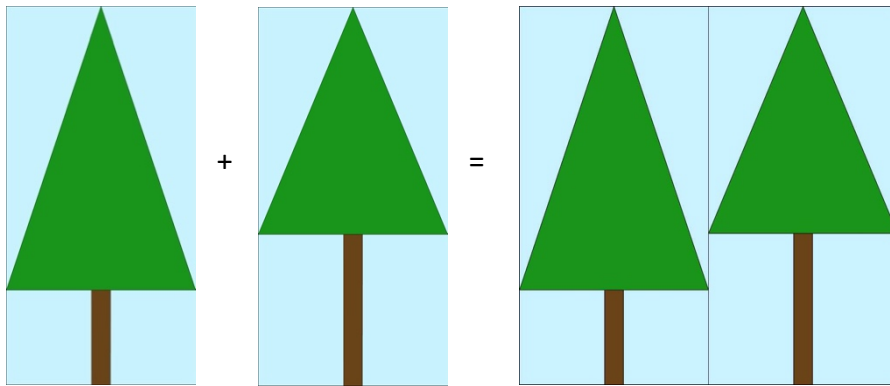
1. Sew together the Bottom sky pieces with the trunk piece as below:
2. Make the top of the tree using foundation piecing with the template on the following page for the left side tree (tree 1) and the template on the page after for the 2<sup>nd</sup> tree (on the right hand side).
3. Place the tree fabric on the back of the printed diagram and pin towards the top and bottom centre. Fold on the diagonal lines and trim the tree fabric so 1/4" from the folded line. Repeat on the opposite diagonal line.
4. Now line up the diagonal of the sky piece with the section you trimmed and sew on the line. As shown below.



5. Fold back, make sure all the outer edges of the diagram are covered.
6. Repeat for the other side.
7. Trim to match the diagram (it should measure 8" x 5-1/2")
8. Sew the sky and tree trunk section to the bottom as shown below.

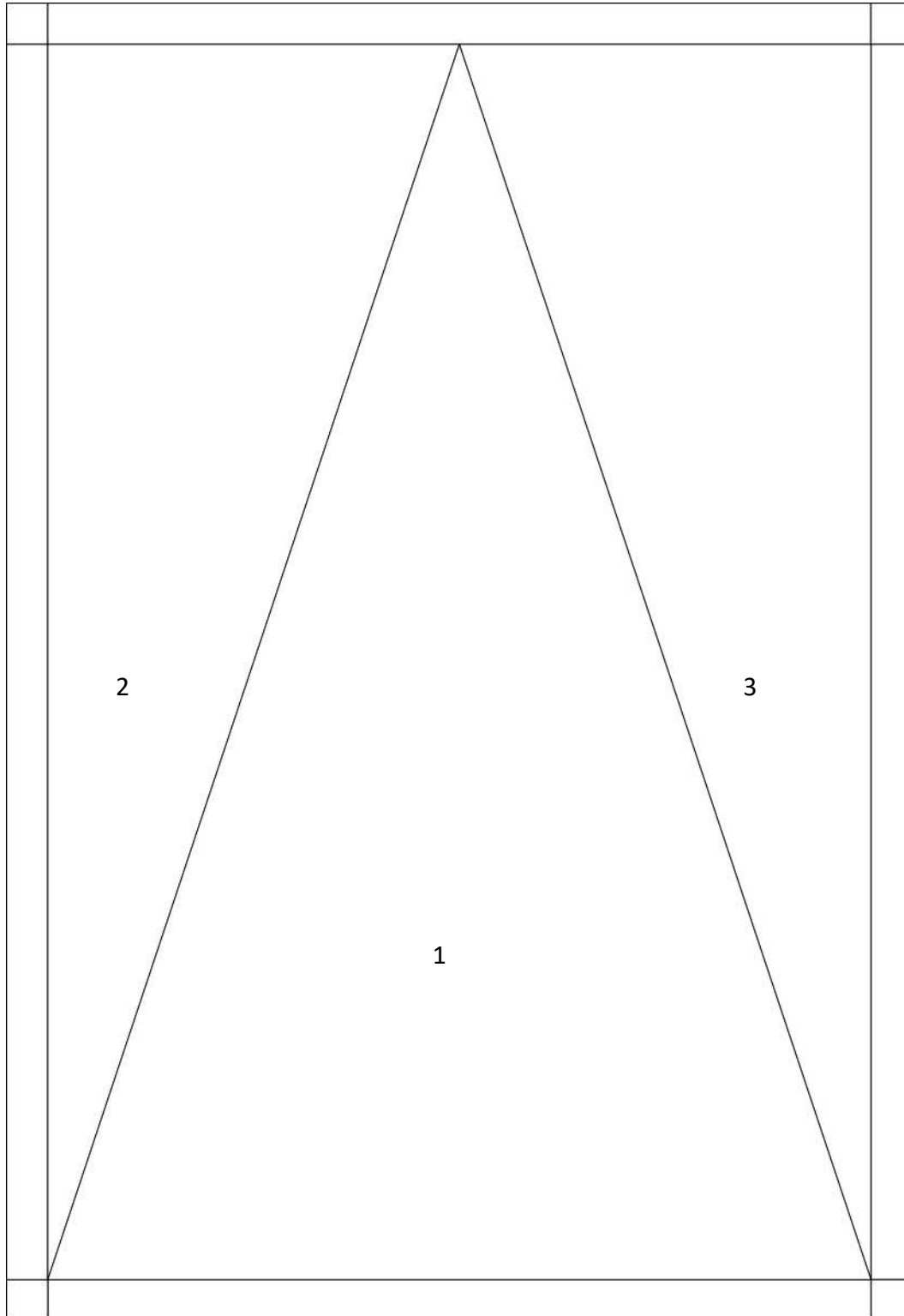


9. Repeat steps 1-8 for Tree 2 (right hand tree) and sew together the two trees as shown below.

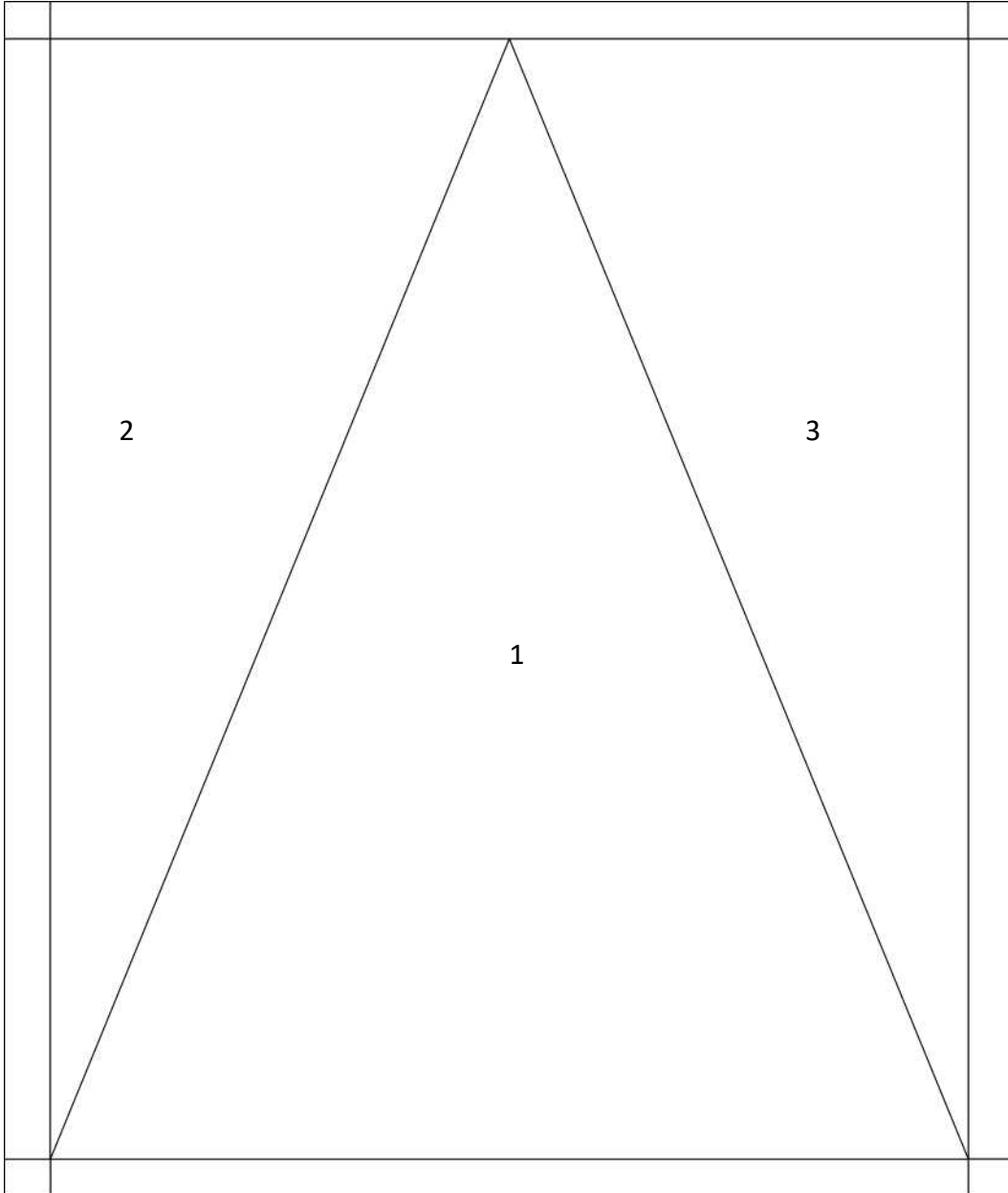


Note: When printing the foundation pattern, be sure your printer is set to 100% on A4 paper, I'm told some printers default to 98%, the foundation will be the wrong size if this is the case.

Left Hand Side Tree

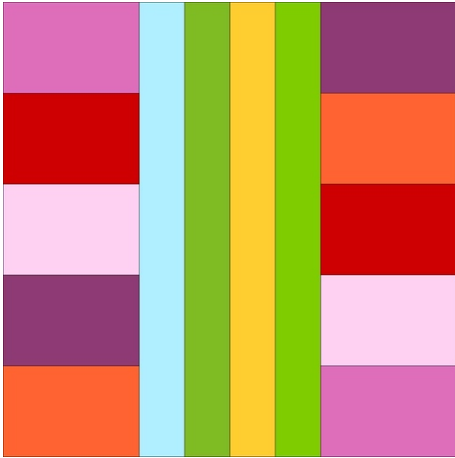


Right Hand Side Tree





## Paths and Gardens 2



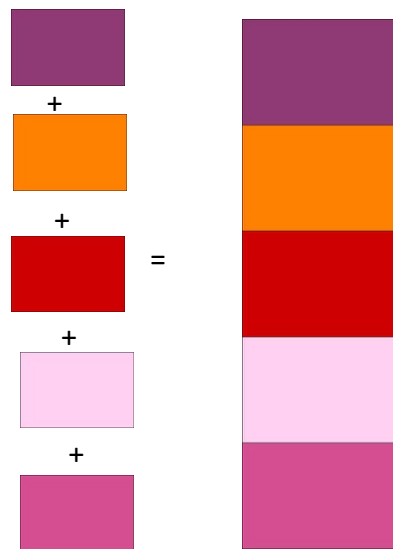
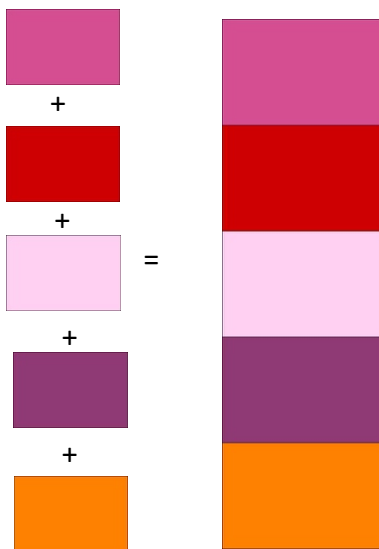
To make this block you'll need the following:

10 pcs – 2-1/2" h x 3-1/2" w in a mixture of colours for the garden

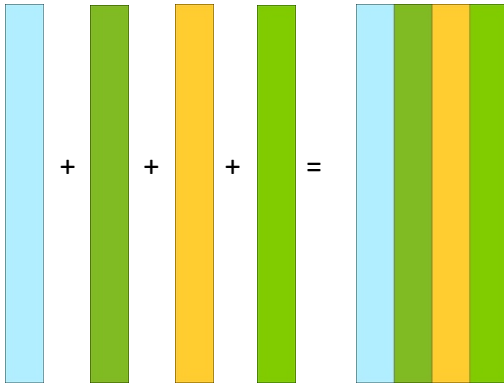
4 pcs – 10-1/2" h x 1-1/2" w in a mixture of colours for the paths

To construct the block

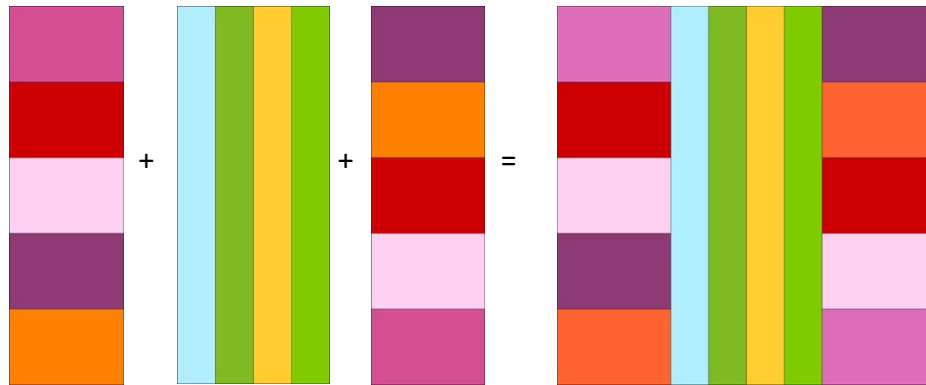
1. Lay out all of your pieces and make sure you're happy with the colour arrangement.
2. Sew together the rectangles on either side as shown below.



3. Sew together the strips for the centre as shown below.



4. Check and make sure you've placed everything as you want and then sew the strips of rectangles to either side of the 'paths'.
